1. Admission fee collected as a percentage of fee charged

As the pool has not opened yet no fees have been collected.

2. Description of community awareness of the facility

The whole community is aware of this project and is eagerly awaiting this asset. An indication of their awareness AND their engagement is that ^{s47F} people have undertaken senior first aid, Occupational Health & Safety, and small motors courses ^{s47F} have also undertaken Lifeguard training with a further ^{s47F} ^{personal privacy} people indicating their willingness to undertake their Bronze Medallion in Lifesaving once the pool is in place. Multiple meetings have been held with the community to gauge their continued engagement and engagement is high.

3. Description of facilities provided with this funding

Facilities will now include three pools – one wading pool and one 12m pool and one 10m (for aquarobics) as ground structure will not sustain a 20m fibreglass pool.

4. Description of initiatives/activities undertaken to improve asset management arrangements including implementation of management plan

As indicated above, the community has been heavily engaged in training themselves to both manage the pool and ensure the safety of those who manage the pool. Discussions have been held with the community regarding management of the pool and the community has asked that the CDEP provider be engaged to include pool management as an activity.

The community has also requested that the Brewarrina Business Centre administer the funds for the pool and collect pool usage fees ^{s47F} ^{personal privacy}

5. Number of Indigenous residents trained and employed through this facility
