In **study 2**, the provider will assess the variation of ASD diagnoses across Australia by conducting a two phase project. In phase one the provider will conduct and video record 20 diagnostic 'gold standard' assessments of children who potentially have ASD. Assessments will be completed by December 2014. In phase two 100 clinicians will be recruited to rediagnose the same cohort of children from the videos created in phase one of the study. Diagnoses by the recruited clinicians will be compared to the original 'gold standard' ASD diagnoses made in phase one to gain an understanding of current variation of ASD diagnosis across Australia.

Findings from both studies will be written up in a final report which is to be presented to the Department and other stakeholders in December 2015.

The provider is responsible for gaining ethics clearance and informed consent from all research participants.
