#### Hi Jacqui

We've been able to confirm that the booklet document is web accessible (a stringent requirement for all of the documents we publish on the website) but we have an issue with the way it prints out. It doesn't seem to be possible to consistently print the document so that all pages print out in the same way, as provided. It would be ideal if the average person who opens the document on the FaHCSIA website can print it out so that it looks like a booklet. At the moment it prints inconsistently - the first and last pages print as A4, and the middle pages print 4 pages to an A4 page etc.

We are unable to open the document in the indd format that you sent in addition to the pdf one.

We accept that the delay in publishing the document has been with FaHCSIA but would ask if you can provide a pdf form that can more easily be printed in a format that the average stakeholder will find useful.
