Performance summary

The National Rental Affordability Scheme (NRAS) is an Australian Government initiative, working in partnership with the states and territories. NRAS approved participants are eligible to receive a National Rental Incentive, comprising Commonwealth and state or territory contributions for each approved home rented to eligible low and moderate income households at a rate that is at least 20 per cent below the prevailing market rates, for up to 10 years.

Report Definitions

In this report:

Active allocations means dwellings tenanted or available for rent.

Provisional allocations means dwellings not yet delivered.

Total allocations means the total number of active allocations and provisional allocations.

Type means the type of NRAS home.

Size means the number of bedrooms in the NRAS home.

NRAS Year means the period 1 May to 30 April each year.


